Whether you're looking to scull for the first time ever, or have been rowing for decades, there are many camp and training opportunities for all age ranges of rowers. Getting a "fresh eyeball" on your technique--and a video to take home with you--can augment your club's existing coaching efforts. We've compiled some great programs sure to result in new friends, good times and faster rowing!

Sculling Camps

All-American Rowing Camp holds its second Masters Sculling Camp June 28-30 in Bloomington on the campus of Indiana University. Coaches include six-time Olympian Jim Dietz, Mark Wilson, Greg Kruczynski and Robert McCracken. Weekend includes technique, drills, rigging advice, nutrition and strength training; six rowing and video review sessions, discussion about racing, training, nutrition, and a weight room session with IU's strength coach. All meals are provided except Saturday dinner. Campers are encouraged to bring their 1x for proper fitting and rigging; however, Vespoli Matrix 1x's will be available as well.
